The turning for Halsway Manor is signposted off the A358 Taunton to Minehead road, about 12 miles from the centre of Taunton. What3Words gives Halsway Manor as *///repaid.fixed.behalf* and the OS reference is ST 12642 38208.

The nearest main line railway station is at Taunton. There is a bus service (no. 28) between the station and Minehead which passes close to Halsway Manor, with a limited Sunday service.

NOTES:

- All costs are per person, and include £5.00 for the music book; Friday dinner is included for both residential and non-residential guests.
- Places are dependent on availability, but it would be helpful to have applications before the beginning of December.
- Shared accommodation must be by consent of all involved.
